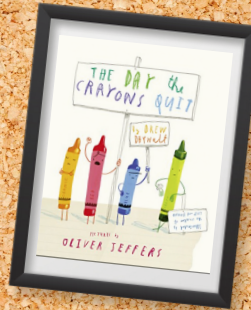
Maths

Place value and the Four Operations:

The place value of each digit; writing numbers in figures and word; ordering & comparing positive integers using inequality notation; understanding decimal place value and using it in the context of money; multiply & divide by powers of 10.

Four operations:

Understand the relationship between addition and subtraction using bar modelling; understand and use the laws of commutativity; use the adjusting method to solve addition and subtraction questions; add and subtract integers using column method; recall multiplication facts and associated division facts; use formal written methods to multiply numbers by a single digit integer; identify the operation required to solve word problems.
