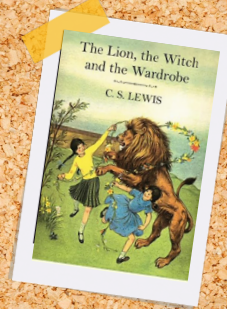
Jungle Class
