



# **CAREERS PROGRAMME**

School for Inspiring Talents



Students will study Preparation for Adulthood weekly throughout secondary school, with all year groups working through the same topics annually. Learning Intentions are designed to be easily differentiated up/down depending on the cohort of students in the year, and are largely linked to pre made lessons from reliable sources (UniFrog / Barclays Life Skills / PSHE Association / educate.against.hate). Lessons are linked where possible to related Gatsby Benchmarks and Fundamental British Values. Each year, students will complete an ASDAN Short Course related to individual students unique needs and trajectories. Each year students also complete a unit entitled 'Community Participation', whereby the aim is for whole classes to work together to pick a need in the local community that they can work to help/support, however some students may need to work in small groups/individually dependant on student need (except year 10 who will complete travel training).
