Ben Digby: Teacher & Outreach Lead Our Outreach provision offers bespoke, nurturing support tailored to each student's needs. Although outreach can work at any level of our schools curriculum spiral, as the reasons to why students cannot access onsite provision widely differs, usually we are working at the foundational level.

This is where there is a focus on creating a welcoming and inclusive environment, providing personalised interventions linked to students EHCP/IPP's on emotional well-being, and social development first and foremost. Through our dedicated approach, we aim to empower every student to feel confident and regulated enough to engage with their learning and integrate into our school community by developing relationships first.

Our students will learn key life skills and be offered cooking sessions in our community hub, as well as physical development and time outdoors in nature. At this level of the curriculum spiral, the learning is therapy weighted, so the academic focus (if possible is Oracy and Reading) and our therapeutic interventions can include equine therapy, animal care, swimming and climbing courses, along with clinical team input if required from speech and language, occupational therapy etc.
